



## INSTRUCTIONS, RULES AND CLOSING DATES.

All entries in Section A and B must be submitted on Monday **7th June** to the art department. The Art Eisteddfod will take place on **Thursday 10th June**.

### 1. Art exhibition - Section A

Houses need to enter a minimum of 4 students in the art exhibition section. These students chosen by their houses will attend the CCA time slot on a Tuesday to complete their house submissions. Students are required to choose from the following list of themes to create an A3 piece or larger for their house submissions.

2021	Isolated	In my neighbourhood
You and me	A vase of flowers	Connecting devices
Monsters from the deep	The winning shot	Festival
Cultural adornments	On my plate	Green

The art exhibition is also open to all other students who would like to submit their artwork for display. Each student who submits an entry for the exhibition will also receive a certificate of participation and a cash award if your entry is judged first or second in each category.

### 2. Creative Design - Section B (compulsory)

Houses need to enter a maximum of 3 students to work as a **team** in the creative design section.

These students chosen by their houses will attend the CCA time slot on a Tuesday to complete their house submissions.

Students will require to use old garments/clothes and repurpose it to make **ONE** creative outfit either for a male or female.

The repurposed outfit will be designed, cut, and pinned together by the chosen students during the allocated CCA time slot.

A tailor will be available for advice and final machine sewing of the garment.

The design will then be worn by a student for the judges to adjudicate.
